About DangerPoint:

DangerPoint provides an inclusive and interactive life skills experience that immerses children in real life situations in a fun and creative way. This gives children the opportunity to develop skills that will support them to make positive choices and manage these scenarios with confidence in the future.

How will this role impact DangerPoint?

The Ranger plays an integral part within the team, delivering interactive tours around the safety education centre, to increase safety awareness among children and other vulnerable members of the community. The activities at DangerPoint may expand as the centre develops.

What will you do for DangerPoint?

1. Deliver agreed key safety messages as a part of a scripted tour of DangerPoint.
2. Provide a warm welcome for the visitors to the centre.
3. Conduct a pre and post quiz with the children using hand held voting devices.
4. Ensure the health and safety of all visitors whilst at the DangerPoint centre
5. Promote and comply with DangerPoint's policies on equal opportunities and Health and Safety, both in the delivery of services and the treatment of others.

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Experience	Why do we need this?
Self-motivated with demonstrable experience of working successfully on own initiative, whilst also being able to work as an integral part of the DangerPoint team.	We are a small collaborative team who work towards a common goal to achieve our values.
Experience of working with children and young people	Most of your time will be spent with children up to 11 years of age so experience is necessary.

Working conditions:

Mainly indoors with a small section where you will deliver road safety on our road scenario where you will be outside for up to 10 minutes each session, however we provide uniform and jackets and there is a canopy overhead in bad weather. There are some stairs up to the lecture theatre and countryside scenario, however there are lifts available if required. You will be required to wear an earpiece and walkie talkie to listen to timings or in case you or the children need support. We aim for one teacher or parent to be with each group each day.

What we will do for you:

We will provide training on the DangerPoint script, quiz and how to use the display equipment. You can shadow another member of the team and then have support until you feel confident to deliver the sessions. Besides contributing to the safety and life skills of thousands of children, you will also be part of a small friendly team and receive these benefits:
